COMING SOON... "CRASH"

Have gotten e-mail from some of you asking why there hasn't been any new work posted to the site since early Spring. Good reason for that – been busy at work on my most time-consuming and complex piece to date – "Crash." This 19" X 47" still life painting showcases a large crash of toy cars. This painting is similar to the award-winning painting "Jam," pictured on the front page of this newsletter. However, "Crash" is twice the size and features three times the number of cars.
